You may take senior courses only if you have completed all first year requirements or you are completing them concurrently. For a Bachelor Degree (Four-Year), an Honors Specialization **or** a Double Major is essential. The Honors Specialization is normally 9.0 senior courses specified by the department. For admission to the Honors Specialization Module, you must complete the first year principal course(s) specified by the department with a minimum average of 70% and a minimum mark of 60%. You must pass the remaining first year courses. You must have a cumulative average of 70% in the Honors Specialization. You may complete an additional Major (6.0) or Minor (4.0) Module if you wish.

ESSENTIAL MODULE:	9.0 or more courses <i>specified by a Department for the Honors Specialization Module</i>
	70% cumulative average in the Honors Specialization Module with no mark below 60%
ESSAYS:	2.0 designated essay courses including 1.0 numbered 2000 or above
BREADTH:	1.0 Category B (eg, Arts & Humanities) course
	1.0 Category C (eg, Science) course
	1.0 Category A (eg, Social Science)
SENIOR COURSES:	No more than 7.0 Year I courses. At least 13 senior courses.
AVERAGES:	60% cumulative average in any additional Module taken
